Answer: 1) **Road:** an open way for travel or transportation Example sentences: 1) We took the country road to meet our relatives. 2) There was a traffic jam on the road.

2) **Coat:** an outer garment with sleeves to make you feel warm Example sentences: 1) I will be wearing coat at the party tonight. 2) She gifted me a black coat on my birthday,

3) **Quickly:** at a fast speed Example sentences: 1) We walked quickly to catch the train. 2) The dog ran quickly to catch the cat.

4) **Stronger:** more powerful Example sentences: 1) Rohan is stronger than Smith. 2) The sun was stronger than the wind.

5) **Cheeks:** either side of the face below the eye Example sentences: 1) Her cheeks are pink in colour. 2) My cheeks get red during winters.

6) **Won:** to be successful or victory Example sentences: 1) Our team won the football match. 2) Saima won the winner championship trophy this year.

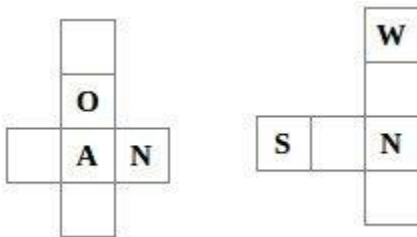

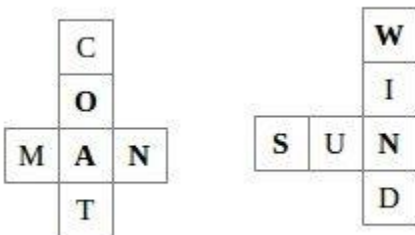
