4) **Penguins:** a large sea-bird with wings for swimming under water Example sentences: 1) She was dancing like a penguin in rain. 2) Penguins' favourite food is fish.

5) **Strutting:** to walk with a proud air Example sentences: 1) He was strutting after he won the music competition. 2) She strutted down the catwalk.

6) **Remarks:** to say something as a comment Example sentences: 1) Her teacher's remarks made her feel bad. 2) You should give remarks at the bottom of the test paper.
